SUBJECT: MIGRATORY BIRD, THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES, AND WETLANDS CLEARANCE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TRUCK MONITOR & RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL DETECTION SYSTEM - MBM -100 - 95

On October 16, 1995 Ecology personnel inspected the installation sites proposed for the construction of Truck Monitor & Radioactive Material Detection System equipment at the North PU&D Yard and the Building 130 Truck Scales. Installation of the monitoring systems at these locations will not impact wetlands, migratory birds, or threatened and endangered species. No wetlands are present, and habitat is unsuitable for threatened or endangered species. Unless structures supporting old bird nests must be removed at either installation site, no migratory bird impacts are expected from this project. According to the project description, no structures are to be removed.

If bird nests will be damaged or removed in the process of installation, Ecology must be contacted to allow acquisition of the appropriate nest removal permit. Otherwise, no further surveys or Ecology services will be required for this project.
