DOE NEPA REGULATIONS SUBPART D
CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION (CX) DETERMINATION - RFFO/CX00-02

Proposed Action: Installation of Field Trailers

Location: Parking areas located north and east of T124A, Rocky Flats
Environmental Technology Site, Golden, CO

Proposed by: U.S. Department of Energy Rocky Flats Field Office (DOE, RFFO)

Description of the Proposed Action:

The Rocky Flats Field Office (RFFO) proposes to install ten trailers and six cargo containers in the T124A parking area. The trailers will be used to support ER personnel through Site closure, and will include areas for labs, a lunch room, showers, and equipment storage. The cargo containers will be used as additional storage areas. These structures are contractor-owned, and will be removed by the contractor when they are no longer needed. The trailers will be anchored into place using trailer anchors, will be connected to Site power, and will be heated and cooled with mounted electrical HVAC units, but will not have water or sewer connections. Water and wastewater will be contained in tanks associated with the trailers. Water will temporarily be run to the trailer from nearby buildings (via aboveground hose) and will later be hauled to the trailer by truck as needed. Wastewater will also be hauled away by truck, although gray water may be initially routed (by aboveground hose) to a nearby sanitary drain. Neither the trailers nor cargo containers will be used for waste storage activities.

Categorical Exclusion to be Applied:

B1. Categorical Exclusions Applicable to Facility Operation

B1.15 Siting, construction (or modification), and operation of support buildings and support structures (including, but not limited to, trailers and prefabricated buildings) within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Covered support buildings and structures include those for office purposes; parking; cafeteria services; education and training; visitor reception; computer and data processing services; employee health services or recreation activities; routine maintenance activities; storage of supplies and equipment for administrative services and routine maintenance activities; security (including security posts); fire protection; and similar support purposes, but excluding facilities for waste storage activities, except as provided in other parts of this appendix (Appendix B).

Justification:

The project is to site and operate trailers and cargo containers within the existing T124A parking areas. The trailers will be installed and operated to support ER activities as cited in CX B.1.15. The facilities will not involve waste storage activities.

In addition, in accordance with 10 CFR 1021.410(b), the project (a) fits within the class of actions listed in Appendix B of Subpart D of 10 CFR 1021, (b) exhibits no extraordinary circumstances that may affect the significance of its environmental effects, and (c) is not "connected" (per 40 CFR 1508.25[a][1]) to other actions with potentially significant impacts, is not related to other proposed actions with cumulatively significant impacts (per 40 CFR 1508.25[a][2]), and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211.

Further, in accordance with 10 CFR 1021, Subpart D, Appendix B, the project would not (1) threaten a violation of applicable statutory, regulatory, or permit requirements for environment, safety, and health, including requirements of DOE and/or Executive Orders, (2) require siting and construction or major expansion of waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment facilities (including incinerators), (3) disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that there would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; or (4) adversely affect environmentally sensitive resources.

I have determined that the proposed action meets the requirements for a categorical exclusion as defined in Subpart D of 10 CFR 1021. Therefore, I approve the categorical exclusion of the proposed action from further NEPA review and documentation.
