RE: Closeout Reports for Trailers 452F, 891F, & 891O and the 560 Cooling Tower

Dear Mr. Legare:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division has reviewed the Closeout Reports for Trailers 452F, 891F, 891O, and the 560 Cooling Tower (B560). All of these facilities have previously been identified as Type 1 facilities. Your letter, dated October 15, 2002, and the Closeout Reports for these facilities were received on October 18, 2002.

In your letter you request our approval of these Closeout Reports. Although we have not previously approved nor are we aware of any requirement to approve the Closeout Reports for Type 1 facilities, prior to considering approval of these Closeout Reports, please provide a discussion regarding the remaining infrastructure associated with each trailer. This should include any slab (concrete or asphalt) that was under the trailer, as well as any water, sewer, or other piping or appurtenances that may have been connected to the trailer. This should also indicate the proposed (by ER) or actual disposition by D&D (removal) of this infrastructure associated with each trailer.

Considering that only the superstructure of B560 has been removed and the concrete basin and buried piping remain, this D&D Closeout Report is not complete. Although the current scope of D&D removal activity may be complete (removal of the superstructure), the actual removal of B560 by D&D (removal of the substructure) has not been completed. Unless the removal of the remaining part of B560 is to be performed by ER, this D&D Closeout Report for B560 cannot be considered complete until all of B560 has been removed. In addition, the November 14, 2001 RLCR concurrence letter included the need to collect additional radiological measurements from the then inaccessible concrete cooling tower basin during demolition, which does not appear to have occurred.


