RE: Acceptance, Closure Summary Report (CSR) for Tank T 207 (T-29)

Dear Mr. Rampe and Mr. Nesta:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the "Division") previously received the subject report dated March 31, 2004. The Division, in a letter dated February 26, 2002, conditionally approved the Closure Description Document (CDD) for the unit as signed by DOE on February 22, 2001, withdrawn on October 11, 2001 and then re-submitted via e-mail on January 11, 2002. The e-mail re-submittal duplicated the withdrawn version; therefore, the original version signed on February 22, 2001 will be retained as the official document.

The Division's February 26, 2002 established three conditions, which were met as indicated:

- The unit was defined as the tank and associated above ground piping that was disposed at Envirocare. As a result, decontamination and application of the Alternative Treatment Standards for Hazardous Debris was not applicable.
- The integrity of the tank floor was confirmed negating the condition for soil sampling.
- The third condition, relative to organic concentrations in previously collected soil samples, was informational and did not affect closure. Further, soils were routinely evaluated under the environmental restoration program.

The specifications of the CDD and the conditions for its approval have been met. Accordingly, the CSR for the unit is accepted. If you have any questions concerning this correspondence, please contact me at 303-692-3367 or Harlen Ainscough at (303) 692-3337.
