Dear Cliff,

The United States Department of Army Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 7 Corps File Number 200380250 expired on May 7, 2005 with no work started. The permit was for the culvert cleaning, sediment removal and placement of riprap for culverts P-1055 and P-1057. Both culverts are being removed as part of the IA Land Configuration Project which is covered by NWP No. 27, Corps File Number 200480620 and therefore no work was required under the NWP No. 7.

The NWP No. 7, Corps File No. 200380250 does require under General Conditions 14. Compliance Certification that "Every permittee who has received NWP Verification from the Corps will submit a signed certification regarding the completed work and any required mitigation." The permit does not discuss what happens if no work is performed. Therefore, I recommend sending the authorization letter and the Certificate of Completed Work, unsigned, with a cover letter explaining the work authorized by this permit is not being done because the culverts are being removed under NWP 27, Corps File Number 200480620.

I have enclosed a cover letter, the Compliance Certification, the authorization letter for Corps File Number 200380250 and the authorization letter for Corps File number 200480620.






