

SUBMITTAL OF OU 1 REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION REPORT JMK-0425-92

In a letter to DOE dated March 13 1992 (letter 92 RF 2212) EG&G Rocky Flats requested DOE submit to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Colorado Department of Health (CDH) an extension request on the Interagency Agreement (IAG) schedule for submittal of the Operable Unit No 1 (OU 1) Remedial Investigation (RI) report This extension request was based on several technical issues detailed in the aforementioned letter

As of May 4 1992 EG&G has received no response from DOE on this request and is therefore in the midst of development of the RI report The IAG milestone schedule for submittal is that the draft is due to DOE on June 2 1992 and to EPA and CDH on July 30 1992

EG&G would like to clarify to DOE that the technical issues cited in the March 13 1992 letter have adversely impacted the data set that is available for generation of the RI report The draft OU 1 RI report that will be submitted on June 2 1992 will have the following deficiencies

- only one quarter of Phase III ground water data (minimum of two required for sound technical base)
- incomplete set of Phase III soils/borings data
- biota tissue analysis data lacking (awaiting lab results)
- majority (80 /) of radionuclide data lacking
- only 20 / of data validated (which is industry acceptable but EG&G has been led to understand EPA expects more)
- Public Health Evaluation will not utilize Phase III data for Contaminant of Concern development

EG&G believes these shortcomings in the RI report are substantial enough to compromise the thoroughness of the entire document
