By letter dated November 3 1994 (94 DOE 11410) we requested a three month schedule extension for Operable Unit No 1 (881 Hillside OU 1) as a result of comments received on the Draft Corrective Measures Study/Feasibility Study (CMS/FS) Your letter dated November 22 1994 granted a thirty day schedule extension with the opportunity for future schedule extensions to be considered on a monthly basis This approach to our original extension had a stated purpose of improving the consultative process

Your comments on the Draft CMS/FS raised several process and programmatic issues In a letter to Joan Sowinski of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and Mark Dupree the Environmental Protection Agency dated November 10 1994 Jessie Roberson proposed a dedicated cadre to address these issues and improve the consultative process As a result of this letter a dedicated cadre from each of our three organizations has been identified to attempt to resolve these process issues and provide consultative process improvement However despite the interest by all parties other priorities have prevented the initial meetings from taking place The first meeting of this dedicated cadre is tentatively scheduled for the week of December 12 1994

Technical concerns were also raised by your comments We have formulated responses which are planned for discussion at a meeting with you scheduled for December 8 1994 Another meeting is tentatively planned for the week of December 19 1994 We believe that we have reflected good faith in attempting to resolve both the technical and consultative process concerns Based on the good faith effort an additional 30 days should be granted at this time Because we are just beginning to resolve comments we do not know the amount of time that will be needed to reach resolution on the comments Because we have not agreed on how we will resolve comments we do not know the total time that will be needed to finalize the CMS/FS Therefore we may be
