Gentlemen:

On April 11, 1995, the Operable Unit 1 (OU 1) Working Group held a meeting to discuss various aspects of the OU 1 Project. Based on those discussions, the Department of Energy (DOE) requests regulatory approval for the following changes in the OU 1 program.

Given the fact that the contamination plume has not migrated down gradient to the French drain, DOE has, at great expense, been treating essentially clean water. Provided this information, the Working Group has decided that DOE should no longer treat the water pumped from the French Drain. Water from the French drain will still be pumped to the collection tanks, will be sampled, and if that water meets the discharge Applicable, Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs), shall be discharged to the Surface Interceptor Ditch without further treatment. Water not meeting ARAR criteria will be treated prior to discharge.

The second program change involves the well monitoring program. DOE currently samples OU 1 wells on a monthly basis. DOE proposed and the Working Group agreed that a quarterly monitoring schedule would be more appropriate and in line with other sitewide well monitoring schedules.
