

Exemption from DOE Order 5820.2A. for Mixed Waste from Environmental  
Restoration and Waste Management Activities

The Rocky Flats Field Office (RFFO) Manager's approval is required to exercise the exemption from DOE order 5820.2A for mixed waste as stated in the referenced memorandum (attached). The memorandum authorizes the DOE Operations Offices to use commercial facilities for the disposal of small quantities of mixed waste. The exemption is to be applied on a case-by-case basis, and this specific exemption is for approximately six cubic yards of Low Level Mixed Environmental Remediation waste, generated from Operable Unit (OU) 1 activities.

The RFFO authorizes EG&G to utilize the exemption to DOE Order 5820.2A for the disposal of Land Disposal Restricted compliant OU1 Contaminated Soil and associated remediation wastes generated from environmental restoration activities at the Envirocare Clive, Utah Disposal facility contingent upon the following:

- Waste acceptance by Envirocare of Utah, Inc. (Envirocare)
- Authorization from the DOE Oak Ridge Operations Office to dispose of the waste under their disposal contract with Envirocare

Prior to shipping, documentation of these above items should be delivered to John Schneider, Leader, Waste Disposal Team. No further authorization to exercise the exemption for this waste stream is required.
