Dear Mr. Rehder, Mr. Schieffelin, Ms. Chaki:

Enclosed for your information is the Accelerated Action Plan for six Underground Storage Tanks (USTs) listed in the Inter-Agency Agreement (IAG) which contain Resource Conservation and Recover Act (RCRA) regulated materials. In summary, this plan outlines interim activities which will remove these USTs as sources of contamination pending final Site remediation. Activities include; removing existing tank contents, rinsing the USTs to remove gross contamination, sampling the rinsate to document the levels of contamination remaining, and filling the USTs with a closed cell foam where necessary to prevent future groundwater infiltration. Personnel from your staff have reviewed and verbally approved the activities listed above in addition to the planned management and treatment of existing tank contents, rinsates and any sludges generated. These personnel are also aware of the probable need to treat the liquids generated by this project at the Operable Unit 1 (OU 1) treatment facility because of the presence of organic contamination in some existing tanks' contents.

As discussed, your concurrence on this approval to these activities except those associated with the closed-cell foaming is requested before mid-January 1996. Concurrence with foaming activities will be addressed through the Proposed Action Memorandum (PAM) process.
