Remedial Investigation

The attached recent letters from the Environmental Protection Agency, Region VIII, and the Colorado Department of Health raise concerns with remedial investigation work on the 881 hillside and with the ground-water monitoring program for the present landfill, solar evaporation ponds and west spray field. An RFAO letter to Rockwell dated July 14, 1988, also expressed concerns about the quality of data in remedial investigation reports. Taken together, these letters indicate that there may be underlying problems with remedial investigation and groundwater monitoring work at Rocky Flats. I would like to know what plans Rockwell has for addressing these concerns. As a first step in this regard, please schedule a briefing for RFAO at your earliest convenience to explain Rockwell's view of these concerns and any underlying problems and causes which you feel need to be addressed.
