The Colorado Department of Health, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division), has reviewed the above referenced document submitted by DOE and prime operating contractor, EG&G. The Division is extremely disappointed that EPA and Division guidance on exposure scenario development for the OU 1 risk assessment was not applied to OU 2. Until this is done, we can not approve TM 5.

The Division requests that an updated version of TM 5 be prepared and submitted for our review and approval. As OU 2 is not under the same time constraints as OU 1, it will not be acceptable to incorporate our comments to this TM into the BRA in the Phase II RFI/RI Report.
