Enclosed are amendments to the Tier II reports for 1992. These amendments add hydrochloric acid, hydrogen peroxide, sodium hydroxide, and sodium hypochlorite to the list of hazardous substances that exceeded reporting thresholds in 1992 and adds Operable Unit #2 (T900D) to the list of storage locations for nitric and sulfuric acid.

These amendments to the Tier II reports are necessitated by newly obtained information on chemical storage associated with ground water and surface water remediation in Operable Units #1 and #2. This information was inadvertently omitted from the Tier II reports submitted earlier on February 24, 1993.
