The U.S. Department of Energy, The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Colorado Department of Health will hold a public information workshop to discuss the assessment of public health risk associated with environmental restoration activities at the Rocky Flats Plant. Workshop participants will learn about the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's risk assessment process and two preliminary risk assessments performed by the U.S. Department of Energy for contaminated areas in Operable Unit No. 3, beyond the Rocky Flats Plant boundary. The two documents containing the risk assessments are the Final Past Remedy Report, which addresses soils, and the Historical Information Summary and Preliminary Health Risk Assessment Report, which addresses reservoirs and drainages.


