In response to your request for a funding source and point of contact for NEWNET, the EG&G Rocky Flats, Inc. (EG&G) point of contact for managing the NEWNET project is Tracey Spence at extension 8551 Los Alamos National Laboratory has indicated that the general scope of work outlined during the January 18, 1995 meeting for application of NEWNET at the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (RFETS) will be funded by the Department of Energy/Headquarters for approximately \$200,000. Additional funding for station installation, administration and management activities, monitoring station operation and servicing charges would be provided under the Operable Unit (OU) 3 Major Activity Document since this project would be partially located within offsite areas

Representatives from Los Alamos met with OU 3 management on February 16, 1995 to further discuss application of the NEWNET environmental monitoring system at RFETS Los Alamos agreed to submit a statement of work to EG&G for the following scope 1) provide (on loan for a one-year trial period) three self-contained meteorological/gamma radiation monitoring stations; 2) calibrate and make operable the three monitoring stations; 3) train EG&G-appointed personnel to operate/service the stations; 4) process, archive, and provide quality control and quality assurance for collected data; and 5) enter data into the NEWNET database and make the data available on Internet Los Alamos is expected to submit a statement of work to EG&G sometime during the week ending March 3, 1995 Following review, EG&G will prepare and transmit a final statement of work with associated identified costs

In addition to providing onsite and offsite real-time environmental monitoring information to the public, we anticipate that data collected through the proposed NEWNET system will augment the existing ComRad monitoring system as well as the Industrial Area Interim Measures/ Interim Remedial Action decontamination and decommissioning verification monitoring program.
