## OPERABLE UNIT NO 5 STORM EVENT LOCATIONS WSB 308 93

The purpose of this memorandum is to clarify the surface water sampling locations along Woman Creek and the South Interceptor Ditch which will be sampled during storm event runoff According to Technical Memorandum No 1 Revised Network Design Field Sampling Plan there are twelve locations to be sampled during base flow conditions and during storm event runoff conditions The following locations were listed

- SW107 SW034
- SW127 SW501
- SW041 SW029
- SW040 SW507
- SW506 SW027
- SW033 SW026

However verbal discussions on March 28 1993 between the EG&G Rocky Flats Inc Surface Water Division (SWD) and the Colorado Department of Health (CDH) have reduced this to include only the following locations for a storm event runoff event

- SW107 SW501 SW034
- SW127 SW029 SW027
- SW506 SW507 SW026

The primary factor is that the travel time for the water through the system is short and a high level of resolution is not necessary The total number of sampling stations deleted by this reduction is six over the course of the program This has an almost negligible effect on the cost of the program The overall surface water sampling task which is a very small part of the total program was reduced by 7/ of the sampling budget This


