Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Environmental Assessment for Construction Activity requirements, it is necessary to inform the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Colorado Department of Health (CDH) of excavations taking place within Individual Hazardous Substance Sites (IHSSs).

Through a phone conversation between our OU staffs on December 8, 1992, the following proposed relocations for the Soil Classification Survey for the Phase 1 RFI/RI Work Plan for Operable Unit (OU) 6, Walnut Creek Priority Drainage, Rocky Flats Plant, were provided to both the EPA and CDH:

There are three soil classification surveys specified in the OU 6 Work Plan. Each of these requires the excavation of a shallow trench. Two of these surveys will be relocated. Soil classification surveys will be relocated from IHSS 166 to IHSS 216.1, and from IHSS 167.1 to 167.3. The soil classification survey specified within IHSS 165 will remain at that location.

The reason for the relocations is that IHSS 166 contains backfilled trenches, not native undisturbed soil. The new location in IHSS 216.1 is an area of undisturbed soil. Relocating the survey from IHSS 167.1 to IHSS 167.3 will provide a better spacial distribution of soil classification within OU6. These locations will also complement the site-wide soil classification effort.
