Actions from Meeting with Colorado Department of Health, June 12, 1991

Reference RFO Memorandum 4822, dated June 17, 1991, attached.

We met with Colorado Department of Health (CDH) personnel from permitting, solid waste and enforcement groups to discuss the plans for the current and new landfills. A number of actions resulted from this meeting which EG&G should be pursuing as identified in the attached meeting minutes. EG&G actions include:

- A. Develop schedule for closure of old landfill.
- B. Develop and implement procedures to preclude introduction of hazardous waste into the landfill.
- C. Investigate requirement for a closure plan to be submitted under Colorado Code of Regulations (CCR) Subtitle D and identify plan for development of closure plan if required.
- D. Develop inventory of asbestos requiring disposal and determine if "one-time landfill disposal action for friable asbestos" disposal is feasible and should be pursued with the CDH and the county.
- E. Set up meeting with CDH to explain mounding of current landfill
- F. Investigate why current validation process for analytical data takes up to 6 months and identify methods to shorten this time.
- G. Determine if current monitoring and analytical data comply with Colorado Code of Regulations or solid waste landfills (are approximately 20 constituents required by CCR being performed and reported to CDH)
- H. Determine the level of radionuclides and other hazardous constituents in the sludges from the water treatment plant. Prepare a brief report for submittal to the Rocky Flats Office discussing the findings and the regulatory impacts, if any, of disposing of the sludges in the existing and proposed landfills
