### RE OU 7 Seep Collection and Treatment Proposed Action Memorandum

Dear Mr Slaten

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) have reviewed this Proposed Action Memorandum (PAM) for OU 7. The Division, acting as lead agency for OU 7, approves the PAM with EPA's concurrence.

As a point of clarification, provisions for treatment of the seep water described in Section 3.1 must be resolved and proposed to the agencies within the timeframes outlined in Table 5-1. The Division and EPA also reiterate that actions proposed under PAMs are to be implemented within six months of the date when the parties agree that they are necessary and appropriate.
