RE: Operable Unit (OU) 9 Dispute

Dear Mr. Slaten:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division), has signed the Resolution Statement for the OU9 Tank Dispute. Paragraph 3 of this resolution states that DOE will submit a plan to investigate Tanks T-24 and T-32 within 75 days of the execution of the dispute resolution. It is further stated that this plan shall include investigation of the soil, groundwater, and tanks in a manner similar to that proposed in TM1 for other tanks in OU-9, including an internal inspection of the tanks, and an investigation of the internal residue with wipe samples or rinse and rinsate sampling.

Information concerning the integrity of these tanks has been received by the Division. Based on a review of this information it has been determined that the internal inspection of the tanks, and an investigation of the internal residue can be deferred until closure of these tanks. Please be advised that it is the Division's understanding that a final decision as to the continued use of Building 881 and hence the need for the use of these tanks has not been finalized. However, the current plan is to convert these tanks from interim status to 90-day use. When a final decision is made this information should be submitted to the Division along with the anticipated date of closure of these tanks. Please be advised that when these tanks will no longer be used for the management of hazardous waste process water generated in Building 881 these tanks will need to be managed in accordance with the provisions in the Interagency Agreement (IAG) and the CHWA Tank closure requirements. It is therefore appropriate that an updated closure plan be submitted for these tanks that will meet the tank closure requirements. These closure plans should be submitted to the Division within 75 days of receipt of this letter.

It has been stated that samples have been taken of sludge contained in tanks located in Building 887. The analytical results of these samples should be submitted to the Division within 5 days of RFETS's

EXTENSION REQUEST FOR RESPONSE TO THE REGULATORY AGENCIES' COMMENTS ON  
STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES (SOPs) - NMH-505-93

Ref: J. K. Hartman ltr (10206) to N. M. Hutchins, Environmental Protection Agency and Colorado  
Department of Health Comments on Standard Operating Procedures

This letter is a request to extend the due date for response to the Colorado Department of Health (CDH) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) comments on the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) GT.08 and the Revised GT.08 document. This request is for one week which would extend the due date to October 8, 1993. This extension is necessary to verify changes to the SOP as it relates to the Industrial Area (IA) Operable Units (OUs). Several approved OU Work Plans reference GT.08 and Technical Memorandum No. 5 for Operable Unit (OU) 1 which may present inconsistent direction for soil sampling. This issue needs to be resolved.

In addition, a Document Modification Request (DMR) made changes to the current data recording form this week. This form needs to be incorporated into this revision of GT.08. According to Document Control, the new form will be available on October 6, 1993.

A draft of the Response to EPA and CDH comments and the latest version of GT.08 has been given to B. K. Thatcher of the Department of Energy, Rocky Flats Office.
