CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION (CX) DETERMINATION RFO/CX028-92

**Proposed Action.** Fuel Storage Tanker Truck Within the Protected Area

**Location:** North of Building 964, Rocky Flats Plant, Golden, CO

**Proposed by:** U S Department of Energy, Rocky Flats Office

**Description of the Proposed Action**

The proposed action is to construct an earthen retention berm and site a 2000 gallon fuel tanker truck north of Building 964 (see Figure 1). The fuel tanker truck would remain parked within the berm and would be used to fuel vehicles within the Protected Area (PA). Vehicles currently have to be inspected each time they leave the PA to be refueled and be reinspected when they return to the PA. Having a fuel supply within the PA would save time and free personnel to perform other duties. The fuel tanker would hold 1000 gallons each of diesel fuel and gasoline.

The earthen berm that would be constructed to surround the tanker truck is required as a safety measure to contain possible fuel spills from the tanker. The berm would be approximately one foot high, would encompass an area approximately 40' x 42' and have the capacity to contain the volume of the tanker truck.

An Unreviewed Safety Question Determination has been conducted for this project. A Safety Analysis Report is not expected to be required.

The action would take place in an already developed area at the Rocky Flats Plant. No wetlands or sensitive areas would be impacted by the proposed action. The estimated cost of this project is \$50,000.

**Categorical Exclusion to be applied.**

B1.6 Installation or modification of retention tanks or small (normally under one acre) basins and associated piping and pumps for existing operations to control runoff or spills (such as under 40 CFR part 112). Modifications include, but are not limited to, installing liners or covers. (10 CFR 1021, Appendix B to Subpart D)




