We are in receipt of your 94-DOE-08163 correspondence regarding the extension we granted to the Industrial Area IM/IRA milestones in our letter of July 14, 1994.

The agencies accept the proposed conditions in order to enable DOE to meet the new milestones. These conditions are i) a five day agency review of the Final Proposed IM/IRA/DD prior to public release (submittal to the agencies on 8/26/94), ii) incorporation of any additional agency comments as part of the public comment revision process, and iii) incorporation of public comments received after 10/18/94 into the final responsiveness summary.

The new milestones in our July 14, 1994 letter are enforceable. Because we accept the conditions you requested, we fully expect DOE to achieve them without limitations or reservations.
