Consolidation of Mixed Residue Storage Areas

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In order to improve future management of mixed residue storage areas, the Department of Energy (DOE) requests an assessment and plan for consolidation of mixed residue storage areas at the Rocky Flats Plant. The preferable location for final consolidation of mixed residue storage is in Building 371. However, intermediate improvement in mixed residue storage areas should be considered for mixed residue storage areas in the Protected Area (PA) until final consolidation can be obtained. The intent of this request is to limit the number of mixed residue storage areas that must be managed in the future and to improve current mixed residue storage areas by limiting storage around gloveboxes, tanks, and other equipment.

As part of the near term effort to improve and consolidate mixed residue storage areas, removal of new equipment that is no longer planned for use should be evaluated. For example, removal of existing new tanks in Building 771, Room 148 and removal of the new Line 30 glovebox and tanks in Building 771, Room 149 might be considered. An evaluation of the waste generated in preparing mixed residue storage areas for consolidation should be included in the assessment.

It is requested that your plan for consolidation of mixed residue storage areas be provided to DOE/RFO by October 9, 1992.
