This memo conveys the referenced report prepared by Kathy M. Hagglund, EG&G. This information was requested informally by the Manufacturing Scientific Corporation and the British Nuclear Fuel Limited (MSC/BNFL), the National Conversion Pilot Project (NCP) Stage I and II Cooperative Agreement participant. The purpose of the informal request by MSC/BNFL was to determine if radiation screening results for Individual Hazardous Substance Site No. 180 posed any problem to meeting the NCP Stage II Cleanup Requirements.

Apparently MSC/BNFL anticipated that an informal response would result from their informal request; however, that was not the case and the referenced report in final form, was provided to them. MSC/BNFL provided Environmental Restoration with a copy during the week of February 13, 1995.

A cursory examination of the report suggests that the laboratory personnel may not be fully aware of the scope of the Operable Unit No. 15 program, or the field sampling procedures and screening techniques utilized. Would you or your staff review this report and, after consultation with the laboratory, advise me of your comments.
