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SYNOPSIS

Personnel from the EPA, CDPHE, DOE/RFFO, EG&G and ERM-RM met this date to present radionuclide screening rationale used to develop the OU-15 Final Phase I RFI/RI Report to State and EPA personnel not familiar with the process and to discuss the closure strategy for OU-15 to be included in the Draft Proposed Plan for the Closure of OU-15, "Inside Building Closures." The following is a brief synopsis of this meeting, which commenced at approximately 9:10 AM on April 3, 1995, at the EPA Region VIII - Conference Center, Timberline Room - Denver, CO.

Dr. Fitch opened the meeting and asked that the attendees introduce themselves. After the introductions were completed, Dr. Fitch, for the benefit of the State and EPA personnel new to OU-15, presented a brief history and description of OU-15. Dr. Fitch then turned the floor over to Mr. Haasbeek for the presentation on the radionuclide screening process and the rationale used for the various approaches used.

Mr. Haasbeek commenced his presentation to the attendees. During this presentation an extensive discussion, concerning the IHSSs, the RCAs, the NCPP, contaminate fate and transport and the model (GEN II) used to calculate the AEDE for IHSS 180, was included and many questions were asked by those individuals unfamiliar with the OU-15 effort. Mr. Haasbeek was joined in providing additional clarification and responding to these questions at various times during his presentation by Mr. Ray, Mr. Schubbe, Mr. Anderson, Mr. Duran, Mr. Spreng and Dr. Fitch. A copy of Mr. Haasbeek's Presentation is attached.

Mr. Duran proposed that in the interest of "Team Spirit" and the collaborative decision making process that EPA felt that OU-15 could be closed as follows:

- All six IHSSs could be RCRA Clean Closed.
- The three IHSSs not located in an RCA (those in Bldg. 881) could be CERCLA Clean Closed for radiological contamination.
- The remaining three IHSSs (one each in Bldgs. 447, 865 and 883) all located in RCAs and all associated with NCPP cleanup efforts could be reincorporated back into the buildings as integral parts of these buildings to be dealt with at the time of "ultimate building disposition."

Mr. Duran stated that the terms "Institutional Controls" and "institutionalize" would not need to be specifically mentioned in the PP and thus the worry of setting precedents within the DOE Complex could be avoided.

Mr. Duran then asked Dr. Fitch his opinion relative to the described approach or strategy for the closure of OU-15 and asked when he thought that the PP would be ready for the EPA and CDPHE to review.

Dr. Fitch then stated that, in his opinion, the strategy proposed for the closure of OU-15 appeared to be acceptable and that he would present it to his management and the OCC for their input.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 11:40 AM.
