Dear Mr. Surovchak:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) has reviewed RFLMA Contact Record 2008-02, which allows breaching of Dams A-1, A-2, B-1, B-2, B-3, and B-4 to reduce active management and maintenance needs. The excavation and construction required for this project will contravene elements of the institutional controls incorporated in the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA). As part of this project, however, the groundwater monitoring well and the surface water monitoring station that will be removed will be replaced. In addition, although soil or sediment will be excavated in some areas to deeper than the 3 feet allowed by RFLMA, the residual risk level to a site user will be maintained at or below  $1 \times 10^{-6}$ .
