Dear Ms. Cox:

Thank you for your letters dated April 8, 2010, expressing the Rocky Flats Stewardship Council (RFSC) concerns relating to the *Rocky Flats Surface Water Configuration* National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Environmental Assessment (EA) and potential Points of Compliance (POC) relocation.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has not released the Draft EA that addresses the dam breaches. DOE, EPA, and Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) have not released a modification to the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) Attachment 2, Legacy Management Requirements, addressing the relocation of the POCs.

We expect that DOE will release the Draft EA and DOE, EPA, and CDPHE will release the proposed RFLMA modifications for public review in early May. At that time, a public review and comment period will begin. We look forward to receiving your formal comments.

Regarding your request for an extended 60-day public comment period, EPA will consult with the other RFLMA parties on the feasibility of extending the comment period. We are interested in continuing to work with the RFSC and all affected governments and organizations and will continue the established practice of involving the public regarding the Rocky Flats Site.
