RE: Release of Proposed Modification to Monitoring Locations at the Rocky Flats Site for Public Review and Comment, dated July 20, 2010

Mr. Plieness, Mr. Spreng and Ms. Moritz:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) released a proposed modification to the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) Attachment 2, Legacy Management Requirements, for public review and comment. The public review period is proposed to end on Friday, August 27, 2010.

The proposed modification addresses eliminating the current five points of compliance established at three of the site's terminal ponds, one on Walnut Creek and one on Women Creek, and reestablishing two new points of compliance. Due to the technical nature and significant potential impacts to downstream asset holders, a 30-day comment period will not provide sufficient time for our staff to fully evaluate and provide meaningful comments on the proposed changes..

With closure of the Rocky Flats Reading Room, additional time is needed to extract technical information from Legacy Management's web site and GEMS system. Accordingly, the City and County of Broomfield requests that you extend the public


