Agencies Extend Public Comment Period on Proposed Plan to Amend the Final Corrective Action Decision/ Record of Decision (CAD/ROD) for the Rocky Flats Site

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) have extended the public review and comment period on the Proposed Plan for the modification of the Rocky Flats CAD/ROD to 60 days. The extension was granted in response to a public request.

This Proposed Plan outlines the amendments intended to clarify the intent of the institutional controls (ICs) that relate to DOE's ability to properly maintain the site. The Proposed Plan, which includes the proposed CAD/ROD amendment and the proposed modification to RFLMA Attachment 2, is available on the Community Involvement page of the Rocky Flats Site website at http://www.lm.doe.gov/Rocky_Flats/Sites.aspx?view=5.

The public review period ends on **Tuesday, August 02, 2011**. Written comments regarding the proposed modification must be sent on or before the end of the public review period to the following addresses for consideration by the RFLMA parties in determining what, if any, changes will be made for final approval of the modification by EPA and CDPHE.


