Subject: Request for Extension of Public Comment Period for the Proposed Plan for Amendment of Corrective Action Decision/Record of Decision (CAD/ROD)


Mr. Elliot:

The Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) Parties (U.S. Department of Energy, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency) received your request for an extension to the public comment period on the Proposed Plan for Amendment of Corrective Action Decision/Record of Decision (CAD/ROD). The Parties are in agreement that the comment period, already extended at stakeholder request from 30 days to 60 days, is sufficient for review of the proposed language changes to the CAD/ROD, the only document currently out for public comment. Public comment will now be accepted on the CAD/ROD Proposed Plan until August 2, 2011.


The related documents to which you refer are final documents which have had extensive public review and discussion and are not the subject of the current public comment period.
