The U.S. Department of Energy has posted RFLMA CR 2014-08, "Provide flexibility to the flow configuration at the Solar Ponds Plume Treatment System (SPPTS) as part of the ongoing optimization effort" to the Rocky Flats DOE Legacy Management website. This contact record documents the approval of the Soil Disturbance Review Plan (SDRP) by the RFLMA Parties. The SDRP is required for the excavation to access the piping to be modified to provide increased flexibility in optimizing the SPPTS operations.

CR 2014-08 was posted on the Rocky Flats DOE Legacy Management website on July 18, 2014. Due to an oversight the email notification of the posting of the contact record on the Rocky Flats website was not made at that time. Therefore, this delayed notification is being issued now. We apologize for the oversight and have implemented additional internal checks to ensure public notification of contact records will be issued in a timely fashion. CDHPE and EPA have been notified of this oversight.

The work related to CR 2014-08 was initiated on July 28 and completed on August 5, 2014, including placing of topcoat aggregate, without incident.
