The U.S. Department of Energy has posted Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) contact record RFLMA CR 2015-01, "Reportable condition for uranium 12-month rolling average at Point of Compliance WALPOC", to the Rocky Flats DOE Legacy Management website.

This contact record replaces contact record RFLMA CR 2014-10, which was rescinded on January 5, and documents the consultation between the RFLMA Parties to address a reportable condition at surface water Point of Compliance (POC) WALPOC at the Rocky Flats Site, Colorado for the period from November 1, 2013, through October 31, 2014. The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment letter rescinding CR 2014-10 is also posted on the Rocky Flats website at the location noted below.
