The U.S. Department of Energy has posted Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) contact record [RFLMA CR 2015-02](#), “*Soil Disturbance Review Plan (SDRP) for Storage Shed Photovoltaic Upgrades*” to the Rocky Flats DOE Legacy Management website.

This contact record documents the consultation between the RFLMA Parties to address proposed upgrades to a storage shed that was constructed around 2001 at the Rocky Flats, Colorado, Site. The project will provide additional power to the storage shed (formerly the east vehicle inspection shed) for operating additional hand tools. Additional photovoltaic (PV) panels are required to provide the additional power.

12-inch diameter holes approximately 3 feet deep will be drilled and filled with concrete. The additional PV panels will be supported on poles mounted to the new concrete footings.

No work will be initiated until 10 days after the notification that this Contact Record has been posted to the DOE Legacy Management website.
