The U.S. Department of Energy has posted Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) contact record [RFLMA CR 2015-03](#), "*Original Landfill (OLF) Immediate Response to Recent Precipitation*" to the Rocky Flats DOE Legacy Management website.

This contact record documents the consultation between the RFLMA Parties to address immediate actions necessary to respond to heavy precipitation in 2015. The heavy precipitation led to unusually high groundwater volumes that, in turn, have caused portions of the OLF—particularly in the area of the East Perimeter Channel—to crack and slump.
