RE: Contact Record 2015-04: MSPTS reconfiguration design and minor Rocky Flats
Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) modifications

Dear Mr. Surovchak,

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), in coordination with Region 8 of the Environmental Protection Agency, has reviewed draft Contact Record 2015-04. This contact record proposes design improvements to the treatment of groundwater collected at the Mound Site Plume Treatment System, which are expected to result in improved contaminant removal and process efficiencies. It also proposes changes to tables and figures in Attachment 2 of the RFLMA.

Our review has determined that the conceptual approach described in the contact record is consistent with discussions among the RFLMA parties and with site visits, and consistent with the final remedy for the Rocky Flats Site. The changes to RFLMA are determined to be minor and do not require public comment. Contact Record 2015-04 is therefore approved.

Subsequent approval will be required for the reconfiguration designs and a Soil Disturbance Review Plan as well as the actual changes to RFLMA Attachment 2. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding this approval.
