Dear Mr. Surovchak,

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), in coordination with Region 8 of the Environmental Protection Agency, has reviewed draft Contact Record 2015-06. This contact record describes emergency actions that were taken at the Original Landfill (OLF) in response to damage to the cover caused by record amounts of precipitation received during the first half of this year and proposes additional interim measures to improve surface water flow off the OLF cover in the short term. Because these measures require excavation subject to Institutional Controls #2 and #3, this contact record provides a Soil Disturbance Review Plan.

Our review has determined that the proposed soil disturbance required by the construction activity supports the function of the remedy and will not result in an unacceptable release or exposure to residual subsurface contamination. The proposed interim actions are consistent with consultation among the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement parties, which occurred on July 22, 2015. The proposed project also meets the rationale and objectives of Institutional Controls #2, #3, and #6 and Contact Record 2015-06 is therefore approved. As noted, soil disturbance authorized by this contact record will not begin until 10 days after stakeholders are notified that this contact record has been posted on the Rocky Flats Site's website. Contact Record 2015-06 also notes that a longer-term solution to stabilizing the OLF cover is being studied.
