“Significant” vs. “non-significant” change would in part depend on the specific wording of the regulatory documents – CAD/ROD, RFLMA, etc. The ROD incorporates the decision documents for the Mound, STTPS and East Trenches as enforceable documents (see p. 69) so it would be important to look to these 3 decision documents and verify exactly what they require. As far as the ROD and RFLMA, they seem to be fairly generic. I can’t easily find those 3 old decision docs in the AR, but think we need to look at them carefully – thanks - Vera

David,

I'll be drafting an approval letter for CR 2015-08 later today. Vera concurs.

I think this may push us closer to the fine line between a significant and a "non-significant" change. Changing from primarily treating U to primarily treating nitrate might be viewed as significant once it's proposed as the "design of a longer-term SPPTS configuration." In the meantime, I see CR 2015-08 as as another step in the ongoing process to study and test optimizing techniques.
