RE: Contact Record 2015-10 – Reportable Condition at AOC Well #10304

Dear Mr. Surovchak,

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), in coordination with Region 8 of the Environmental Protection Agency, has reviewed draft Contact Record 2015-10. This contact record describes the US Department of Energy's (DOE) response to a reportable condition at AOC Well #10304 due to a repeat exceedance of the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) water-quality standard for trichloroethylene. Once results were validated, DOE informed CDPHE on December 1, 2015.

As a next step to evaluate this condition, DOE has proposed taking grab samples at a downstream location in the Woman Creek drainage as long as the well remains reportable. When results of these samples are available, the RFLMA parties will again consult concerning possible additional actions. This process is in accordance with protocols in Attachment 2 of the RFLMA and the proposed action is consistent with the final remedy for the Rocky Flats Site. Contact Record 2015-10 is therefore approved.
