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The U.S. Department of Energy Office of Legacy Management has posted Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) Contact Record [RFLMA CR 2016-03](#), "Geoprobe Investigation of the Groundwater System Upgradient of the Original Landfill and the Soil Disturbance Review Plan," to the Rocky Flats Legacy Management website at [http://www.lm.doe.gov/Rocky\\_Flats/ContactRecords.aspx](http://www.lm.doe.gov/Rocky_Flats/ContactRecords.aspx).

RFLMA CR 2016-03 summarizes the RFLMA parties' consultation and includes the soil disturbance review plan. The Geoprobe investigation is intended to better identify groundwater flow conduits and to install small wells or piezometers in specific areas to better understand groundwater characteristics. In all cases, the Geoprobe will be used on the flat bench above the Original Landfill and outside of the identified waste footprint. As specified in RFLMA, no work will begin on this project until 10 calendar days following distribution of this notification.
