To Whom It May Concern:


I would like to register my strong opposition to the currently Proposed Amendments to the CAD/ROD for the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site.

Public comment must be sought in the event that any of the institutional controls for the agreement are amended. Specifically, in the event that there are any proposals to disturb the soil below 3 feet, public comment must be considered.

I strongly believe that CDPHE must not be able to unilaterally make decisions with respect to soil disturbances.

I have serious concerns about possible plutonium contamination at Rocky Flats and believe that no land should be available for a toll road or bicycle path. Any intended construction could stir up clouds of plutonium-laden dust potentially harmful to construction workers, nearby residents, and others.
