

# The Rocky Flats Plant invites you to comment

Work Plan for Control of Radionuclide Levels in Water Discharges from the Rocky Flats Plant

The U.S. Department of Energy invites the public to offer comments on the Proposed Work Plan for Control of Radionuclide Levels in Water Discharges from the Rocky Flats Plant. The document describes surface water sampling and analytical methods and limitations for determining radionuclide levels; summarizes statistical assessments of accumulated analytical data; and recommends additional radionuclide studies of the quality of water discharged from the plant.

A 60-day public comment period for the Proposed Work Plan for Control of Radionuclide Levels in Water Discharges from the Rocky Flats Plant begins September 24, 1991, and ends November 22, 1991. Information on the document will be provided to the public at the Quarterly Public Information Meeting on Environmental Restoration on October 17.

A second meeting will be held on November 6 to accept oral comment on the document. Also, written comments are encouraged during the public comment period and will receive equal consideration.
