

Dear Mr. Lockhart,

The Colorado Department of Health, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division), has reviewed the above referenced documents prepared by DOE and its prime operating contractor, EG&G. We also attended the staff-level meeting regarding these documents on December 5, 1991, at which several broad issues were identified which will necessitate revision and resubmission of the documents. Based on a letter to the Division dated December 18, 1991, DOE has proposed to resubmit these documents on February 21, 1992 (91-DOE-11061). The Division hereby agrees to this resubmittal date. We anticipate, and look forward to, further cooperation between the regulatory agencies and DOE during this period. We emphasize, however, that significant extensions have already been incorporated into the schedule for this document. An approvable PPCD and RS is expected on February 21, 1992.
