Ongoing Evaluation of Processes at the Rocky Flats Plant that Generate Hazardous and/or Mixed Wastes

We are in receipt of the EG&G document entitled, "Identification of Hazardous Waste, Radioactive Mixed Waste, and Mixed Residue Generating Processes at RFP," Revision 1, dated June 11, 1993, as well as EG&G's responses to comments on the initial draft of this document. As you are aware, this analysis will be used to help support our declarations and representations to the court in settlement of the Sierra Club lawsuit. You are therefore directed to continue to support this effort on a priority basis until such time as this matter is fully resolved. The final report and certification statement will be required from EG&G as to the accuracy of the information in the report by July 9, 1993. The details of this statement can be developed in conjunction with the RFO Office of Chief Counsel.

Our review of the aforementioned document in light of our possible representations to the court indicate that a new category of operations should be added to the analysis. This category is operations that are currently not ongoing, but that are anticipated to start in the future. Your analysis of this category should include whether or not the operation is essential according to the existing criteria, and whether and how much hazardous/mixed waste will be generated. The analysis should also indicate when any given operation is anticipated to start. These operations may be incorporated into the tables already produced, as long as each operation that is not now ongoing is identified as such, along with its prospective start date.

I would also like to inform you that my staff will be forming a team, under the direction of Rick DiSalvo of the Regulatory Compliance Branch, to review the aforementioned analysis for completeness and correctness, and to examine the rationale provided to continue or suspend individual operations. I expect that EG&G supporting documentation for its determinations will be made immediately available to team members at their request, and that comments and concerns expressed by the team will be expeditiously addressed and incorporated into future versions of this analysis.
