PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS FOR THE SITE-WIDE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The Department of Energy (DOE) announces its intent to prepare a Site-Wide Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) on the operations at the Rocky Flats Plant located near Golden, Colorado. Public Scoping Meetings will be held in conjunction with developing the EIS. The Site-Wide EIS will identify and assess potential impacts and also present a full evaluation of the cumulative environmental affects of current operations and reasonably foreseeable future actions, including proposed near-term (within 5 to 10 years) projects and near-term environmental restoration activities at the Rocky Flats Plant.
