

## Notification of Signature of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit Federal Facility Compliance Agreement

The purpose of this memorandum is to formally notify EG&G Rocky Flats of the signature of the Federal Facility Compliance Agreement (FFCA) pursuant to Rocky Flats' National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The FFCA was entered into between the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Rocky Flats Office and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region VIII, with signature by DOE occurring on March 19, 1991, and signature by EPA occurring on March 25, 1991. A copy of the signed FFCA is enclosed. The notification of signature of this document to the operating contractor at Rocky Flats is required under Section VI.C. of the FFCA, and this memorandum is intended to fulfill that requirement.

Please note that the signature of the FFCA puts in effect additional reporting requirements for ongoing monthly monitoring of the sewage treatment plant and the Plant's Terminal Ponds. These requirements are found in Sections II. A. and B. of the FFCA. Sections V. A. and B. of the FFCA mandate that the results of this monthly monitoring be submitted to EPA with the Discharge Monitoring Report for that month. Please begin reporting of the data collected pursuant to Sections II. A. and B. with the data being collected for the month of April 1991, to be reported with the DMR submitted on May 28, 1991. Your staff has expressed some concern that the monitoring and reporting requirements of the FFCA are unclear. We recognize that concern, and are in the process of requesting an integrated sampling matrix from EPA. Until such time as we receive this from EPA, our general guidance in this area is to interpret the FFCA conservatively, and to monitor and report all parameters at all locations not specifically excluded or changed by the FFCA. Finally, we ask that all data collected at the STP and the Terminal Ponds pursuant to Sections II. A. and B. of the draft FFCA that have not already been submitted to EPA be summarized and transmitted to us no later than May 15, 1991, for subsequent transmittal to EPA.


