SUBJECT: Closure of the 10 CFR 1022 Process

EG&G Rocky Flats, Inc.

As noted in your recent letter concerning the floodplain/wetland process for the installation of sediment samplers, compliance with the regulations at 10 CFR 1022 is now complete for that project. In the future, compliance with 10 CFR 1022 will be considered complete for all projects involving wetlands (not located within a 100 year floodplain) when a public Notice of Involvement has been published in the *Federal Register* with a 15 day comment period, and a Floodplain/Wetland Assessment that considers any comments received has been prepared. In addition, if an activity is planned within the 100 year floodplain, a Statement of Findings is required to be published in the *Federal Register*, followed by a 15 day public review period to complete the 10 CFR 1022 process.
