


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- 11) Tank/pipeline residue sampling (including wipe samples for radionuclides).
- 12) Any special sampling required for RFI/RI surface water and sediment sampling at OUs 3, 5 and 6 not detailed in the current surface water volume, and
- 13) Any additional required activities which may not be identified within the above list.

Note that many of these activities are currently planned for RFI/RI field work in 1992. Also note that both EPA and CDH have stated that we cannot perform these activities until the SOPs have been prepared, reviewed and approved. Thus, if work has not already begun to prepare SOPs for the above-listed activities, we request that it begin immediately. We do not want the absence of SOPs to add to the current list of reasons for delays in RFI/RI field work at the RFP.

If SOPs have been prepared or are in preparation for any of the above-listed activities, we request that DOE/RFO be notified in writing by June 30, 1992. In addition, if an SOP is in preparation, state the expected date of completion. Upon completion they should be forwarded to DOE/RFO for review and transmittal to EPA, CDH and the Natural Resource Trustees.
