This letter is sent regarding the Colloid Polishing Filter Method (CPFM) technology demonstration at Rocky Flats Plant (RFP). The parties to the IAG agreed to consider this Demonstration Project as part of the Site-wide Treatability Study Plan (TSP) under the IAG. This demonstration project was given high priority under the TSP for FY 93. Therefore, EPA grants approval of the CPFM technology demonstration.


The CPFM technology demonstration is sponsored by EPA's Superfund Innovative Technology Evaluation (SITE) Program. EPA Cincinnati will transfer the appropriate funding to DOE for implementation of the demonstration. In an effort to avoid delays associated with the transfer of funds, EPA expects DOE to utilize current FY 93 funding to implement the demonstration. DOE informed EPA that the TSP projects, which may be affected by this funding transfer are: the TRU/Clear, the Pondcrete Process Evaluation, and the Solar Detoxification Study. EPA expects DOE to carry out the affected projects during FY 94 utilizing the funding transferred to DOE by EPA Cincinnati. If there are other funding affects, please define those impacts and forward the analysis to EPA for our review.

EPA appreciates DOE's cooperation and commitment in facilitating the implementation of the CPFM technology demonstration at RFP. We look forward to working together in the development and implementation of innovative technologies at RFP in an effort to increase our ability to deal with RFP contamination problems.
