Start up funding for the Rocky Flats Site Wide Environmental Impact Statement (SWEIS) has been placed in the budget for FY '94. The goal of the SWEIS is to provide all-inclusive, umbrella National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation for current and foreseeable future activities at the plant in one document. We are anticipating that a lot of progress will be made on the SWEIS during the year, and we will require EG&G's cooperation and support of both the Rocky Flats Office and the Parsons Brinkerhoff SWEIS preparation team to get the SWEIS off to a good start.

The SWEIS team will be contacting organizations throughout the plant site during the year to gather information, identify issues, and validate materials and data that they have prepared. Preparation of the SWEIS is an activity that will benefit all programs and projects at Rocky Flats, and all organizations will be expected to fund their own participation in the SWEIS process out of their existing work packages. For organizations other than EG&G's Ecology and NEPA Division, we expect that only a few days of time away from other projects will be required to meet the requests of the SWEIS team.

We invite all plant employees to take a personal interest in having input into the SWEIS process both on and off the job. As we initiate the SWEIS, we have an opportunity to make it the best and most useful document that it can be. We feel that the time contributed to the effort by any plant organization will be a good investment in the future and play a part in charting a clear course for the future of the plant.
