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

Cut Off Date for Interim Actions During Preparation of the Rocky Flats Site Wide Environmental Impact Statement

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As you know, the Site Wide Environmental Impact Statement (SWEIS) team has been gathering data from DOE staff and EG&G, and the initial sections of the Rocky Flats SWEIS are currently being drafted. This information has also been used to develop a description of the alternatives to be analyzed in the SWEIS, including the No Action alternative

No Action is intended to represent a benchmark at Rocky Flats against which the other alternatives can be compared. In order to have a benchmark that is not a moving target, we need to establish a point at which significant changes in the baseline and the preparation of environmental assessments (EAs) for those activities are curtailed.

The SWEIS team has identified the date of publication of the draft SWEIS in February of 1996 as this cutoff date. This would mean that any site activities requiring preparation of EA's that are planned to be implemented before the Record of Decision is published in October of 1996 must have an approved EA before February 1996. No major changes in Rocky Flats activities should be planned to occur in the window between February 1996, and October 1996 unless an EA has been completed.

Currently, EAs are in preparation for four projects at Rocky Flats:

- Actinide Solution Processing
- Special Nuclear Material Consolidation
- CTMP Treatment Systems 3 and 2/4B
- Surface Water Structures Management

This memo is notification to program and project managers that these four EAs need to be completed before February 1996. Any other programs or projects that are contemplating initiating activities before or during the cutoff window and that do not have existing National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation should evaluate whether an EA should be started now in order to be completed by the cutoff date. Managers of programs or projects not listed above should notify the NEPA Compliance Officer by January 30, 1995 of their intention to prepare an EA and complete it before the cutoff date.
